Members of SLSQ Affiliated Clubs who wish to compete at State Championship events have the ability to apply for exemptions to the requirement for patrol hours and/or a late proficiency (with adequate reason).

This refers to members who

- have not completed the necessary number of patrol hours between 01 January 2020 31 December
  2020
  - AND/OR
- who have not completed the necessary proficiency prior to 31st December 2020.

Members and Clubs are asked to complete the <u>Patrol Hours Exemption & Late Proficiency Request Form</u> and submit to their respective Branch prior to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2021.


